I would like to thank everyone that completed one of our usage surveys last week! The information you provided was very helpful as we strive to continue offering the services you need and expect from your library! As you are aware, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to spread throughout our community, state, and country. Because of the state regulations we must follow in order to remain open, we are forced to operate at a 50% staffing level, quarantine all materials that have been returned, and disinfect the library several times daily, until further notice. 
Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday: 10 am – 4 pm
