Marcia Rieder attended the OVUC board of directors meeting August 27. 28 grants were approved. The Friends were approved for the \$5000. grant which will be used to support the 2026 summer learning program. Marcia is now working on the report for OVUC as to how the grant for 2025 was used. There are 31 teams scheduled for the golf scramble. Cyber Security program is moving forward. Our schools in the county did not respond for this program. OVUC asked Marcia to contact the two school districts in the county. Henry County Schools had not received information on the program but are interested. The Eminence superintendent was not available; she left information for him. This program is free to the schools. The Eminence Schools have not responded. The Henry County School District requested a meeting, so Marcia met with Superintendent, Dr. Jim Masters, and the Chief Information Officer, Andy Buchholz. They are very interested in the program and will contact OVUC directly if district personnel decide to move forward with this program.
